4 General conditions for the tests

Replace the subclause by:

4.2 Addition:

NOTE 1 Three additional coffee mills and grain grinders are required for the test of 19.101.

NOTE 2 The additional test of 25.14 is carried out on a separate appliance.

7 Marking and instructions

Add the following:

7.1 Modification:

Appliances shall be marked with **rated power input**.

20 Stability and mechanical hazards

20.2 Replace the last paragraph by the following:

*For blenders, **detachable parts**, except lids, are not removed. The test is carried out with a test finger similar to that of figure 1 but having a circular stop plate with a diameter of 125 mm instead of the non-circular plate, the distance between the tip of the test finger and the stop plate being 100 mm.*

20.104 Replace the text by the following:

It shall not be possible to operate the cutting blades of blenders, other than **hand-held blenders**, when they are accessible.

Compliance is checked by the following test.

Detachable parts are removed. It shall not be possible to operate the appliance if the cutting blades can be touched with the test finger specified for blenders in 20.2.
