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Introduction

This amendment specifies the additions, to the existing Systems Management Architecture Recommendation, for management knowledge. Management knowledge is necessary in order that two systems may interoperate as they need a common understanding of the management messages that may be communicated between them. The amendment to the Systems Management Overview is a high level statement concerning the need for management knowledge and ways that it may be maintained. The actual management knowledge, which includes class and instance information concerning management information, is specified in ITU-T Rec. X.750 | ISO/IEC 10164-16.

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
