Foreword

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Amendment 1 to ISO 3822-3:1997 was prepared by Technical Committee ISO/TC 43, *Acoustics*, Subcommittee SC 2, *Building acoustics*.

Introduction

EN 1567:1999¹⁾ specifies only a Q_N ; Q_2 and Q_1 are not specified. For example, the Q_N given for DN15 is 0,35 l/s, which is lower than $Q_2 = 0,38$ l/s as specified in ISO 3822-3:1997, Table 2. This amendment makes ISO 3822-3:1997 compatible with EN 1567:1999.
