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FOREWORD

1 SCOPE AND FIELD OF APPLICATION

This International Standard specifies the dimensions and tolerances of pirns with rings (27 mm and 30 mm) for automatic winding at the loom for single-colour and multi-colour weaving.

3 COLOUR CODING

Pirns for use in multicolour weaving shall be colour-coded as shown in table 2.

Pirns specifically for single-colour weaving shall not be so coded.

4 DIMENSIONS

The dimensions shall be as shown in the figure and in table 1. The complementary dimensions are given in ISO 143.

The use of metallic feeler sleeves, reflective strips and other details of barrel profile is optional. A metallic shield or ferrule on the tip is optional (but not recommended), but the use of such a shield or ferrule on the base of the butt is forbidden.
