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## Foreword

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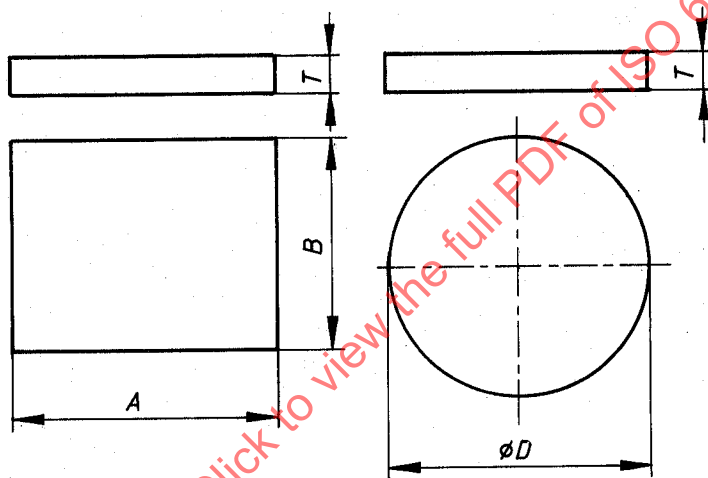

This International Standard lays down the nominal dimensions in millimetres of machined plates for press tools, moulds, jigs and fixtures.
