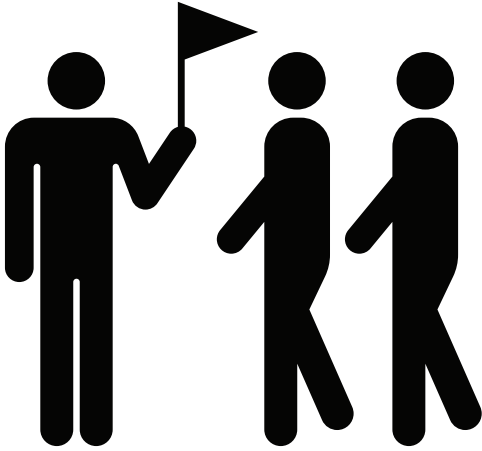

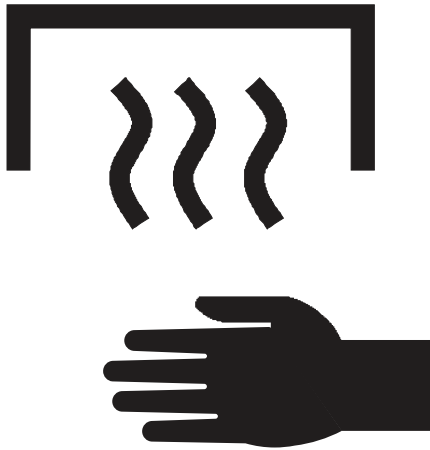

Human behaviour that is intended to be caused after understanding the public information symbol's meaning Understanding how to operate an automatic faucet or tap.	
Need To help people understand that the faucet or tap is operated by a sensor.	
Related meanings	
Field of application Public facilities, transport facilities, commercial facilities.	
Context of use This symbol is used in a public place like a shopping mall or a plaza, and is also found in the street. Usually it can be found on a location sign in or near a toilet.	
Intended user population General population.

Test data obtained according to ISO 9186-1 are not available from more than one country. Findings from national testing, however, showed that in one country the symbol exceeded the criteria of acceptability. It is recommended that this symbol is accompanied by text to increase comprehension.
