This International Standard specifies the characteristics of cross-recessed raised countersunk (oval) head tapping screws with thread sizes from ST 2,2 to ST 9,5 inclusive.

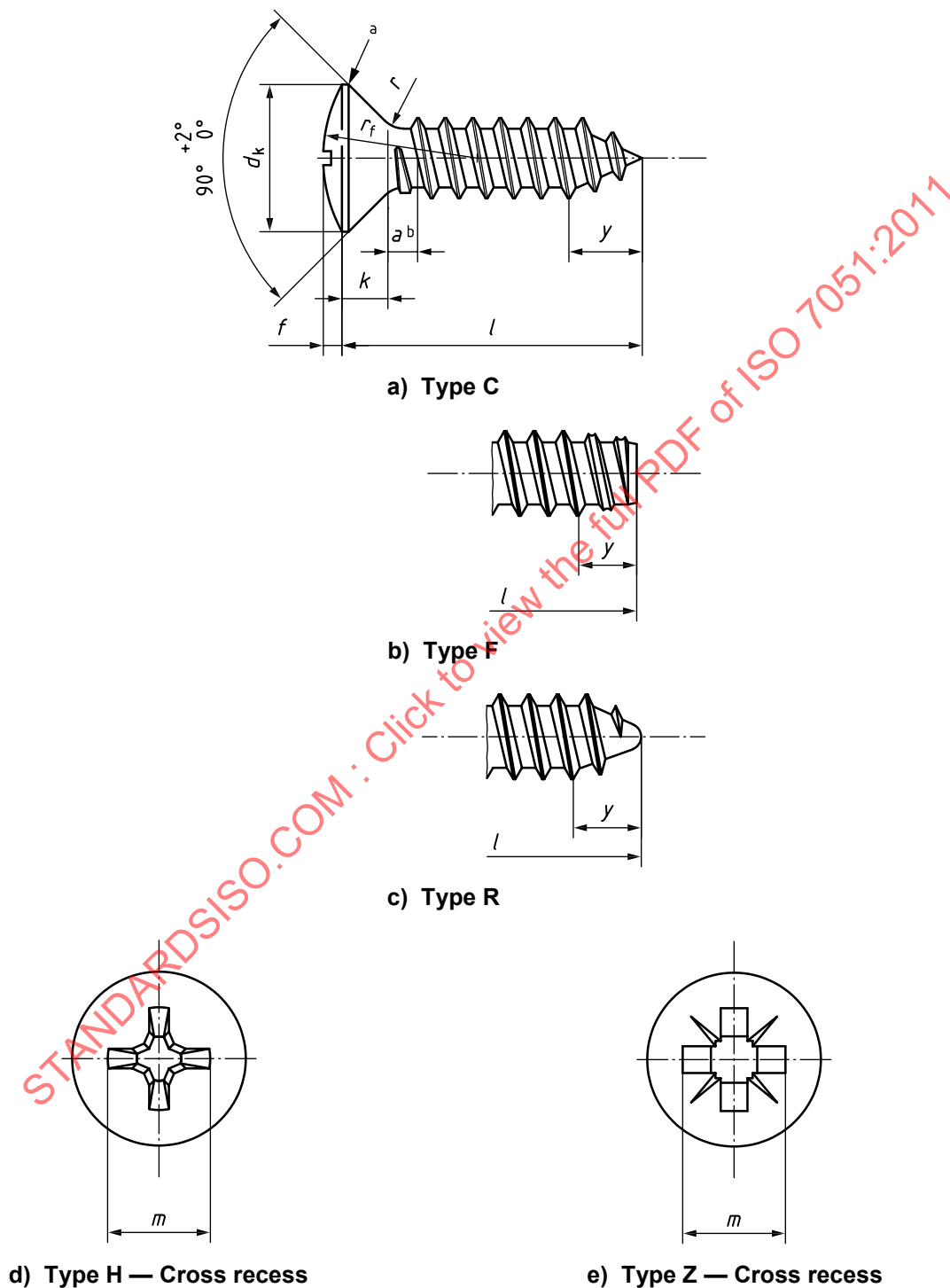

5 Designation

EXAMPLE 1 A cross-recessed raised countersunk (oval) head tapping screw with thread size ST 3,5, nominal length $l = 16$ mm, made of steel (St) in accordance with ISO 2702, rounded end (Type R) and cross recess Type Z is designated as follows:

Tapping screw ISO 7051 - ST 3,5 × 16 - St - R - Z

EXAMPLE 2 A cross-recessed raised countersunk (oval) head tapping screw with thread size ST 3,5, nominal length $l = 16$ mm, made of stainless steel (A4-20H) in accordance with ISO 3506-4, rounded end (Type R) and cross recess Type H is designated as follows:

Tapping screw ISO 7051 - ST 3,5 × 16 - A4-20H - R - H
