Agricultural tractors — Mountings for front ballast weights

0 Introduction

The purpose of this International Standard is to ensure interchangeability of removable front ballast weights between different agricultural tractors.

1 Scope and field of application

This International Standard specifies the load-carrying capacity and the essential dimensions of mountings for removable front ballast weights suitable for use on agricultural tractors equipped with a bar of rectangular section.

2 Load-carrying capacity

The load-carrying capacity of the mountings shall be not less than 1 kg/mm of transverse length.

3 Dimensions

The cross-sectional dimensions of, and the minimum clearances around, the mountings shall be as shown in the figure.

NOTE — The edges of the mountings should preferably be rounded or chamfered.

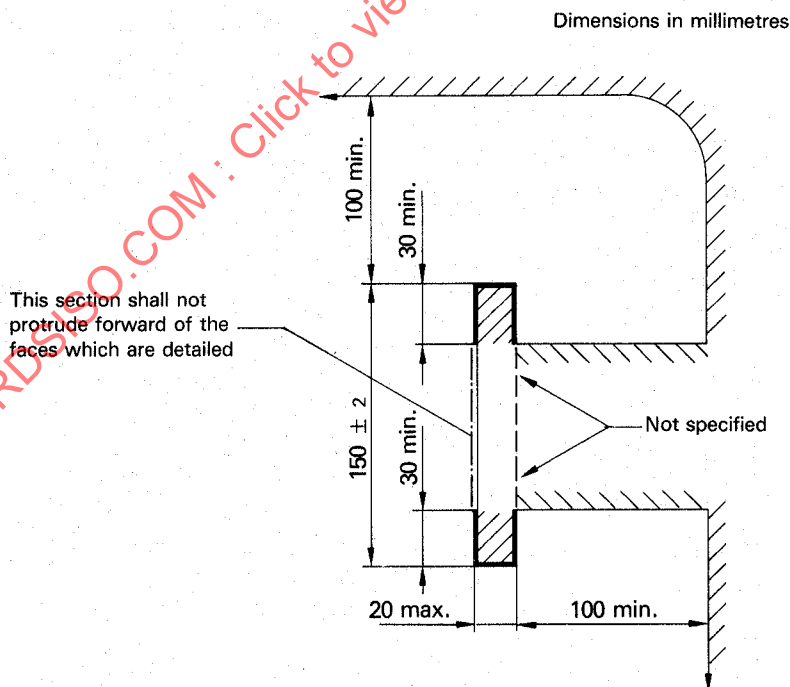


Figure — Cross-sectional dimensions and minimum clearances
