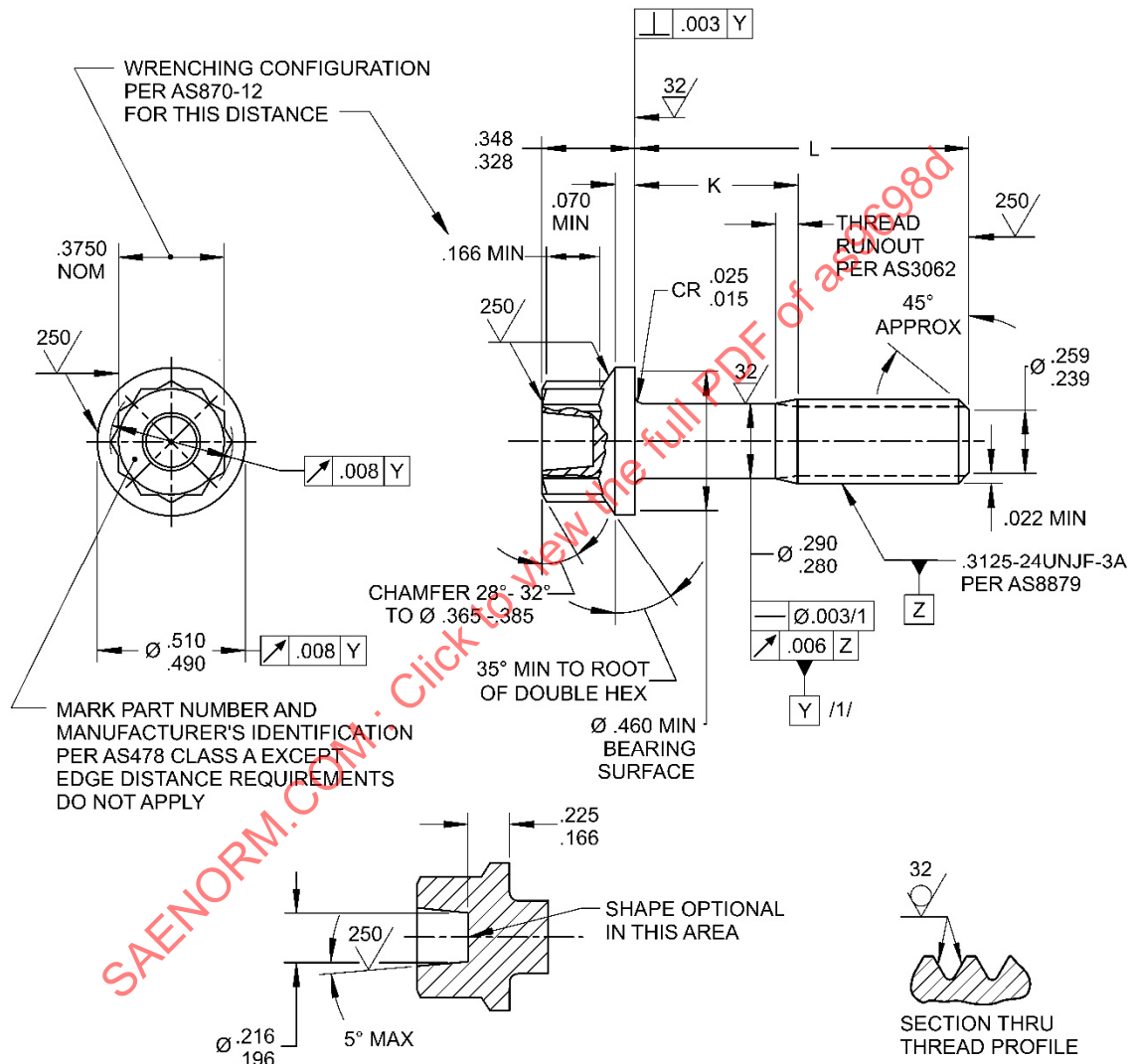

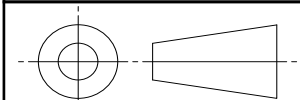


SECTION THRU HEAD
